Consecrated Stewards offers trained Guest Leaders who conduct an organized stewardship emphasis in congregations to help awaken the Spirit-led desire to make a free and joyous response to the grace of God in Jesus Christ.

Journey of Discovery is a five-week Bible study series designed to help congregations explore their stewardship practices during their annual financial stewardship program.

Joyful Response provides a free electronic stewardship program giving families a convenient, safe and simple way to fulfill stewardship commitments and school tuition.

K.I.D.S. Stamp Program teaches children stewardship at an early age. The K.I.D.S. Stamp Program allows children to visualize and understand stewardship with a “Share, Save, Spend” bank to fill their K.I.D.S. Stamp books, then redeem them for an LCEF investment account.

Kids Count Curriculum is an easy to use set of complete lesson plans to educate K-8th grade students about stewardship by providing activities, games, skits, and service projects.




